

Brakes Coppice Park is a beautiful campsite situated in a quiet, secluded valley at the heart of the stunning and historical 1066 Country

Brakes Coppice Park has three camping fields, the main field is the largest and contains the toilet block (NEWLY EXTENDED AND RENOVATED). The second field is where you can find our fishing lake and has an area for both tents and caravans with some electric pitches. Our third field is smaller and more secluded and is for family camping.

The coarse fishing lake is small but well stocked. It is for campers use only and fishing is free for 2011, normal conditions apply. Remember to bring your own rod!



The woodland surrounding *Brakes Coppice Park* is exclusively for campers use. All year they are beautiful, but particularly in the Spring during Bluebell time. We also boast many other varieties of wild flowers including orchids. The wildlife is diverse too and a quiet stroll in the woodland will allow you to find a plethora of creatures.



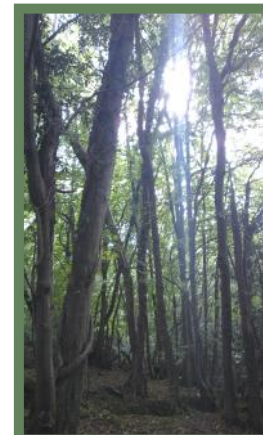

On site facilities include:

- Pitches with hook-ups all with their own aerial point (providing 8 channels at digital quality).
- Many pitches are hard standing (in main field).
- Full toilet block with separate disabled facilities and washing up sinks. All hot water is provided without charge and is available 24 hours a day.
- Laundry with washing machine, tumble dryer and iron (coin operated) with disabled access.

- Barbeques are allowed (for the use of cooking only).
- Children's adventure play trail for all ages to enjoy (very young children with parental assistance).
- A small shop providing basic essentials, sweets, ice creams and newspapers (to order in advance) and a range of Calor and Camping gas (see website for opening times).
- Free DIY freezer block service and well stocked tourist information point.
- Plenty of drinking water taps and waste and chemical disposal points.
- Dogs are welcome but must be quiet and on a lead at all times and should be exercised off the camping fields.

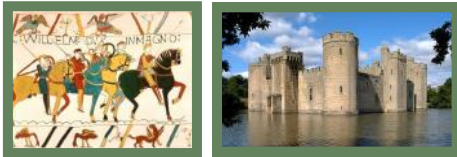




Local Attractions

Historic Hastings and Bexhill are both close by with all the main attractions that seaside towns have to offer.

Battle, famous for its Abbey and Battlefield also has a good selection of shops and a varied choice of places to eat and drink. The surrounding area has numerous visitor attractions for all ages, and our Tourist Information point is always well stocked with their details.

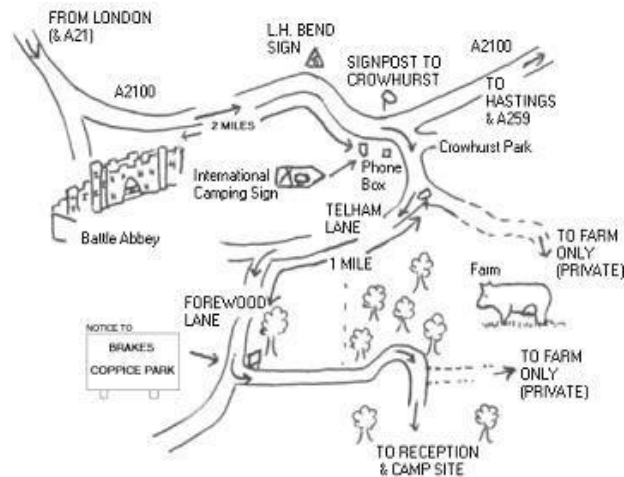
The 1066 area also has many mapped walks, so whether you are a committed hiker or just fancy a gentle stroll, there are plenty to choose from.

Within the village of Crowhurst there is a RSPB reserve with many walks. There are also two pubs within walking distance (1 mile).

Brakes Coppice Park is within a short walking distance (10-15 minutes) of Crowhurst railway station which enables you to use the train for trips to Hastings, Battle and London if you wish to travel further afield.

How to find us

From Battle High Street, follow the A2100 towards Hastings for approximately 2 miles. Turn right into Telham Lane (signposted "Crowhurst"). Continue into Forewood Lane and Brakes Coppice Park's entrance is 1 mile on the left. Continue down our private lane to the reception.



- Late arrivals (after 8pm) are requested to contact us by phone. No new arrivals after 9pm. Our security barrier is locked between 11pm and 7am each night.
- Traders, light goods vans and commercial vehicles are not accepted at Brakes Coppice Park on any occasion.
- We recommend advance booking for school and Bank Holidays.
